**Would like + to + infinitive**

<b>Affirmative</b>	I'd like to go for a walk	
<b>Negative</b>	He wouldn't like to eat a pizza	
<b>Questions</b>	would you like to go to the swimming pool?	
<b>Short answer</b>	Yes, I would	No, I wouldn't

2. Present continuous for future plans / intentions**Affirmative : verb "to be" + ING****Negative : verb "to be in negative" + ING**
